- **Ready for Anything:** The school helps you get ready for high school and even big universities all around the world when you grow up.

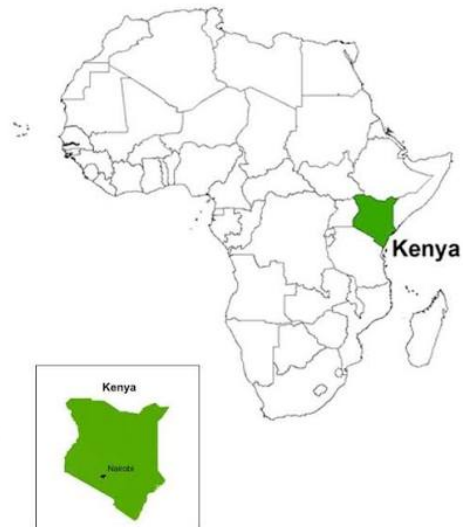
