

Olympic race between the Millau Viaduc, the pyramid of Louvre and the Triumph Arche! They live running





This cable-stayed bridge made of reinforced concrete and steel was then presented as an architectural masterpiece: 2,460 m long and above all 343 m high at the top of one of the pillars.

The road itself (the A 75) is located 270 m above the Tarn valley (Aveyron).

At this altitude, the wind can blow up to 200 km/h.

These dimensions make the Millau viaduct the highest bridge in the world.
